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Daily Life & Habits

Dua for Waking Up

Transliteration: Alhamdu lillahil-ladhi ahyana ba'da ma amatana wa-ilayhin-nushur.

Translation: All praise is for Allah who gave us life after having taken it from us and unto Him is the resurrection.

Dua Before Sleeping

Transliteration: Bismika Allahumma amutu wa-ahya.

Translation: In Your Name, O Allah, I die and I live.

Dua After Eating

Transliteration: Alhamdu lillahil-ladhi at'amani hadha wa razaqanihi min ghayri hawlin minni wa la quwwatin.

Translation: All praise is due to Allah who fed me this and provided it for me without any might or power from myself.

Dua After Wudu (Ablution)

Transliteration: Ashhadu an la ilaha illallahu wahdahu la sharika lahu wa ashhadu anna Muhammadan 'abduhu wa rasuluhu.

Translation: I bear witness that none has the right to be worshipped except Allah, alone without partner, and I bear witness that Muhammad is His slave and Messenger.

Dua Before Entering the Toilet

Transliteration: Bismillahi, Allahumma inni a'udhu bika minal-khubthi wal-khaba'ith.

Translation: In the name of Allah. O Allah, I seek refuge in You from the male and female evil spirits.

Dua After Leaving the Toilet

Transliteration: Ghufranaka.

Translation: I seek Your forgiveness.

Dua for Leaving the House

Transliteration: Bismillahi, tawakkaltu 'alal-lahi, wa la hawla wa la quwwata illa billah.

Translation: In the name of Allah, I place my trust in Allah, and there is no might nor power except with Allah.

Dua When Looking in the Mirror

Transliteration: Allahumma anta hassanta khalqi fahassin khuluqi.

Translation: O Allah, just as You have made my physical form beautiful, make my character beautiful as well.

Dua Before Wudu (Ablution)

Transliteration: Bismillah.

Translation: In the name of Allah.

Dua for Wearing New Clothes

Transliteration: Alhamdu lillahil-ladhi kasani hadha (ath-thawba) wa razaqanihi min ghayri hawlin minni wa la quwwatin.

Translation: All praise is due to Allah who has clothed me with this (garment) and provided it for me without any might or power from myself.

Dua When Sneezing

Transliteration: Alhamdulillah.

Translation: All praise is due to Allah.

Dua When Angry

Transliteration: A'udhu billahi minash-shaytanir-rajim.

Translation: I seek refuge with Allah from the accursed devil.

Dua for the Host After Eating

Transliteration: Allahumma barik lahum fima razaqtahum, waghfir lahum warhamhum.

Translation: O Allah, bless them in what You have provided for them, and forgive them and have mercy on them.

Fasting & Ramadan

Dua for Breaking Fast (Iftar)

Transliteration: Dhahabaddh-dhama'u wabtallatil-'urooqu, wa thabatal-ajru inshaa'Allah.

Translation: The thirst has gone, the veins are moistened, and the reward is confirmed, if Allah wills.

Dua for Fasting (Suhoor)

Transliteration: Wa bisawmi ghadin nawaytu min shahri ramadan.

Translation: I intend to keep the fast for tomorrow in the month of Ramadan.

Dua for Lailatul Qadr (Night of Power)

Transliteration: Allahumma innaka 'afuwwun tuhibbul-'afwa fa'fu 'anni.

Translation: O Allah, You are forgiving and love forgiveness, so forgive me.

Travel & Protection

Dua for Traveling (Safar Ki Dua)

Transliteration: Subhanal-ladhi sakh-khara lana hadha wa ma kunna lahu muqrinin. Wa inna ila Rabbina lamunqalibun.

Translation: Glory be to Him who has subjected this to us, and we could not have otherwise subdued it. And indeed we, to our Lord, will surely return.

Dua for Anxiety and Sorrow

Transliteration: Allahumma inni a'udhu bika minal-hammi wal-hazani, wal-'ajzi wal-kasali, wal-bukhli wal-jubni, wa dala'id-dayni wa ghalabatir-rijal.

Translation: O Allah, I seek refuge in You from anxiety and sorrow, weakness and laziness, miserliness and cowardice, the burden of debts and from being overpowered by men.

Dua When Returning from a Journey

Transliteration: Ayibun, ta'ibun, 'abidun, li-Rabbina hamidun.

Translation: We are returning, repenting, worshipping, and praising our Lord.

Dua When Entering a Market

Transliteration: La ilaha illallahu wahdahu la sharika lahu, la hul-mulku wa la hul-hamdu, yuhyi wa yumitu, wa Huwa hayyun la yamutu, biyadihil-khayru, wa Huwa 'ala kulli shay'in qadir.

Translation: There is none worthy of worship except Allah, alone, without partner. To Him belongs all sovereignty and praise. He gives life and causes death, and He is living and does not die. In His hand is all good and He is over all things omnipotent.

Prayer & Worship

Dua e Qunoot (Witr Prayer)

Transliteration: Allahumma-hdini fiman hadayt, wa 'afini fiman 'afayt, wa tawallani fiman tawallayt, wa barik li fima a'tayt, wa qini sharra ma qadayt.

Translation: O Allah, guide me with those whom You have guided, and strengthen me with those whom You have

given strength, take me to Your care with those whom You have taken to Your care, Bless me in what You have given me, Protect me from the evil You have Ordained.

Dua for Istikhara

Transliteration: Allahumma inni astakhiruka bi'ilmika, Wa astaqdiruka bi-qudratika, Wa as'alaka min fadlika Al-'azheem.

Translation: O Allah, I seek Your counsel by Your knowledge and I seek Your assistance by Your power, and I ask You from Your immense favor.

Dua After Adhan (Call to Prayer)

Transliteration: Allahumma Rabba hadhihid-da'watit-tammah, was-salatil-qa'imah, ati Muhammadan al-wasilata wal-fadilah, wab'ath-hu maqaman mahmudan alladhi wa'adtah.

Translation: O Allah, Lord of this perfect call and established prayer, grant Muhammad the intercession and favor, and raise him to the honored station You have promised him.

Duas for Exams and Success

Dua for Exams and Studying

Transliteration: Rabbi zidni 'ilma.

Translation: My Lord, increase me in knowledge.

Dua for Memory and Speech (Prophet Musa)

Transliteration: Rabbish-rah li sadri, wa yassir li amri, wahlul 'uqdatan min lisani, yafqahu qawli.

Translation: My Lord, expand for me my breast [with assurance] and ease for me my task and untie the knot from my tongue that they may understand my speech.

Duas for Forgiveness

The Chief of Forgiveness (Sayyidul Istighfar)

Transliteration: Allahumma anta Rabbi la ilaha illa Anta Khalaqtani wa ana 'abduka, wa ana 'ala 'ahdika wa wa'dika mastata'tu, A'udhu bika min sharri ma sana'tu, abu'u laka bini'matika 'alayya, wa abu'u laka bidhanbi faghfir li fa innahu la yaghfirudh-dhunuba illa Anta.

Translation: O Allah, You are my Lord, there is none worthy of worship but You. You created me and I am Your slave. I keep Your covenant, and my pledge to You so far as I am able. I seek refuge in You from the evil of what I have done. I admit to Your blessings upon me, and I admit to my misdeeds. Forgive me, for there is none who may forgive sins but You.

Hardship & Distress

Dua of Prophet Yunus (In the Whale)

Transliteration: La ilaha illa anta subhanaka inni kuntu minadh-dhalimin.

Translation: There is no deity except You; exalted are You. Indeed, I have been of the wrongdoers.

Dua for Settling Debt

Transliteration: Allahummak-fini bihalalika 'an haramika, wa aghnini bifadlika 'amman siwaka.

Translation: O Allah, suffice me with what You have made lawful so that I have no need of what You have made unlawful, and enrich me with Your bounty so that I have no need of anyone but You.

Mosque & Congregation

Dua for Entering the Mosque

Transliteration: Allahumma-ftah li abwaba rahmatik.

Translation: O Allah, open the doors of Your mercy for me.

Dua for Leaving the Mosque

Transliteration: Allahumma inni as'aluka min fadlik.

Translation: O Allah, I ask You from Your bounty.

Health & Sickness

Dua When Visiting the Sick

Transliteration: La ba'sa tahurun in shaa' Allah.

Translation: Do not worry, it will be a purification (for your sins), if Allah wills.

Dua for Seeking Cure (Shifa)

Transliteration: Allahumma Rabban-nasi, mudhhibal-ba'si, ishfi Antash-Shafi, la shafiya illa Anta, shifa'an la yughadiru saqaman.

Translation: O Allah, Lord of mankind, remove the hardship. Heal, for You are the Healer. There is no healing except Your healing, a healing that leaves no illness behind.

Nature & Weather

Dua When It Rains

Transliteration: Allahumma sayyiban nafi'an.

Translation: O Allah, (bring) beneficial rain clouds.

Dua Upon Hearing Thunder

Transliteration: Subhanal-ladhi yusabbihur-ra'du bihamdihi wal-mala'ikatu min khifatih.

Translation: Glory be to Him whom thunder praises, and the angels [praise] out of awe of Him.

Dua for Seeing the New Moon

Transliteration: Allahumma ahillahu 'alayna bil-yumni wal-iman, was-salamati wal-islam, Rabbi wa Rabbukal-lah.

Translation: O Allah, bring it over us with blessing and faith, and security and Islam. My Lord and your Lord is Allah.

Dua When the Wind Blows

Transliteration: Allahumma inni as'aluka khayraha, wa a'udhu bika min sharriha.

Translation: O Allah, I ask You for its good, and I seek refuge in You from its evil.

Family & Parents

Dua for Parents

Transliteration: Rabbir-hamhuma kama rabbayani saghira.

Translation: My Lord, have mercy upon them as they brought me up [when I was] small.

Dua for a Newborn Child

Transliteration: Barakallahu laka fil-mawhubi lak, wa shakartal-Wahib, wa balagha ashuddahu, wa ruziqta birraha.

Translation: May Allah bless you with His gift to you, and may you (the parents) give thanks to the Giver, and may the child reach the maturity of years, and may you be granted its righteousness.

Duas for the Deceased

Dua When Entering a Graveyard

Transliteration: As-salamu 'alaykum ahlad-diyari minal-mu'minina wal-muslimin, wa inna in shaa' Allahu lalahiqun, as'alullaha lana wa lakumul-'afiyah.

Translation: Peace be upon you, O inhabitants of the dwellings, believers and Muslims. And indeed we, if Allah wills, will join you. I ask Allah for well-being for us and for you.

Dua for Condolences

Transliteration: Inna lillahi ma akhadh, wa lahu ma a'ta, wa kullun 'indahu bi'ajalin musamma, faltasbir waltahtasib.

Translation: Verily to Allah belongs what He took and to Him belongs what He gave, and everything with Him has an appointed time. So be patient and seek reward from Him.

Dua When Tragedy or Loss Strikes

Transliteration: Inna lillahi wa inna ilayhi raji'un. Allahumma-jurni fi musibati wa akhlif li khayran minha.

Translation: Indeed we belong to Allah, and indeed to Him we will return. O Allah, reward me in my affliction and replace it for me with something better.

Quranic Prophetic Prayers

Dua of Musa (For Provision/Help)

Transliteration: Rabbi inni lima anzalta ilayya min khayrin faqir.

Translation: My Lord, indeed I am, for whatever good You would send down to me, in need.

Dua for a Righteous Spouse & Children

Transliteration: Rabbana hab lana min azwajina wa dhurriyyatina qurrata a'yunin waj'alna lil-muttaqina imama.

Translation: Our Lord, grant us from among our wives and offspring comfort to our eyes and make us an example for the righteous.

Dua for Speech and Confidence

Transliteration: Rabbish-rah li sadri, wa yassir li amri, wahlul 'uqdatan min lisani, yafqahu qawli.

Translation: My Lord, expand for me my breast [with assurance], and ease for me my task, and untie the knot from my tongue, that they may understand my speech.

Duas for Protection

Dua for Protection from Hellfire

Transliteration: Allahumma ajirni min an-nar.

Translation: O Allah, save me from the Fire.

Dua Seeing Someone in Affliction

Transliteration: Alhamdu lillahil-ladhi 'afani mim-mabtalaka bihi, wa faddalani 'ala kathirin mimman khalaqa tafdila.

Translation: All praise is for Allah who saved me from that which He has afflicted you with, and blessed me greatly over many of those whom He has created.

Dua for Protection from the Dajjal (Antichrist)

Transliteration: Allahumma inni a'udhu bika min 'adhabi jahannam, wa min 'adhabil-qabr, wa min fitnatil-mahya wal-mamat, wa min sharri fitnatil-masihid-dajjal.

Translation: O Allah, I seek refuge in You from the punishment of Hellfire, and from the punishment of the grave, and from the trials of life and death, and from the evil of the trial of the False Messiah (Dajjal).

Dua for Protection from the Evil Eye (Nazar)

Transliteration: A'udhu bi kalimatillahit-tammami min kulli shaytanin wa hammatin wa min kulli 'aynin lammatin.

Translation: I seek refuge in the perfect words of Allah, from every devil and every poisonous reptile, and from every evil eye.

Morning & Evening Adhkar

Dua for the Morning

Transliteration: Allahumma bika asbahna, wa bika amsayna, wa bika nahya, wa bika namutu, wa ilaykan-nushur.

Translation: O Allah, by You we enter the morning and by You we enter the evening, by You we live and by You we

die, and to You is the Final Return.

Dua for the Evening

Transliteration: Allahumma bika amsayna, wa bika asbahna, wa bika nahya, wa bika namutu, wa ilaykal-masir.

Translation: O Allah, by You we enter the evening and by You we enter the morning, by You we live and by You we die, and to You is the destination.

Food & Drink

Dua After Drinking Milk

Transliteration: Allahumma barik lana fihi wa zidna minhu.

Translation: O Allah, bless us in it and give us more of it.

Dua Before Drinking Zamzam Water

Transliteration: Allahumma inni as'aluka 'ilman nafi'an, wa rizqan wasi'an, wa shifa'an min kulli da'.

Translation: O Allah, I ask You for beneficial knowledge, abundant provision, and healing from every illness.

Marriage & Relationships

Dua for a Righteous Spouse and Children

Transliteration: Rabbana hab lana min azwajina wa dhurriyatina qurrata a'yunin waj'alna lil-muttaqina imama.

Translation: Our Lord, grant us from among our wives and offspring comfort to our eyes and make us an example for the righteous.

Dua of Musa for Good Provision (and Marriage)

Transliteration: Rabbi inni lima anzalta ilayya min khayrin faqir.

Translation: My Lord, indeed I am, for whatever good You would send down to me, in need.

Wealth & Provision (Rizq)

Dua for Abundant and Halal Rizq

Transliteration: Allahummak-fini bihalalika 'an haramika wa aghnini bifadlika 'amman siwaka.

Translation: O Allah, suffice me with what You have allowed instead of what You have forbidden, and make me independent of all others besides You.
